Distances: All matches will be shoot on Yards

Foreign shooters will be allowed to pay onsite at the range, credit cards are welcome.

Targets: There will be used cardboard targets with white background manufactured by Braun Druck

Weapons / Equipment: No controll will be hold, but the shooter will be responsible for the weapon and equipment.

The match direction reserves to make random checks.

If a shooter believe to have been disadvantaged by an other shooter unfair behaviour or by a weapon, ammo, equipment not matching the rules, he must be remarked it to a range officer as soon as possible.

Ammunition: In none matches are magnumloads od high-speed ammunition allowed. Any caliber that energy is higher than 600 joule, will be classified as magnumload.

Score card: For each match, the shooter will receive a score card. It will be shooter care that his score card will be compiled by the shooter in charge for his target check. The card, signed with the name of the scorer and countersigned by the shooter must be delivered to the office within 30 minutes from the related shooting relay. The Card is definitive.
Missing results are not considered. If more shots than preview are scored, the higher value shot will be deleted up to reach the correct shot number. Complaints against this action are not allowed.

Scoring: Every shooter will score the targets of the shooter on his right side. The rightmost shooter (line13) will score line 1 targets. During the target check the shooter will not be byside his own target an he will not influense the scorer decision. This behaviour if carried out, will be figured as unsportsmanlike and passible of disqualification.

A shooter can not score his own targets also the targets when the shooters are from the same club.

Who has scored the target, will sign in the results to the score card and leave the compiled Score shiet on the targets. The shooter will be then check the score card and its correspondence with the targets. If he will not according with the score, he will bring the targets and score card to the match direction.

Range Officer: Range officer instructions must be followed and obeyed except in case of evident error. Any complaint must be solved immediatly through the match direction.

Regelverstöße: If a shooter believe to have been disadvantageded by an official or an other shooter he must be marked it to a range officer or the match direction immediatly.

Match Direction: The match direction will decide in all affairs.
Complaints against this decision may be submitted to the jury, see A.4.10.1.2. SpO.

Alcohol: Shooters under alcohol effects before the relay start will be immediatly excluded from the competition. Any shooter result will be withdrawn and the entry fee will nor be returned. The kind and the amount of alcohol are irrelevant.

Unsportsmanlike behaviour: f the match director desided a shooter behave unsportsmanlike, he will be disqualifiedaded.
I The entry fee will be expired.

Clothes: Paramilitary clothing will not be acceptet.
